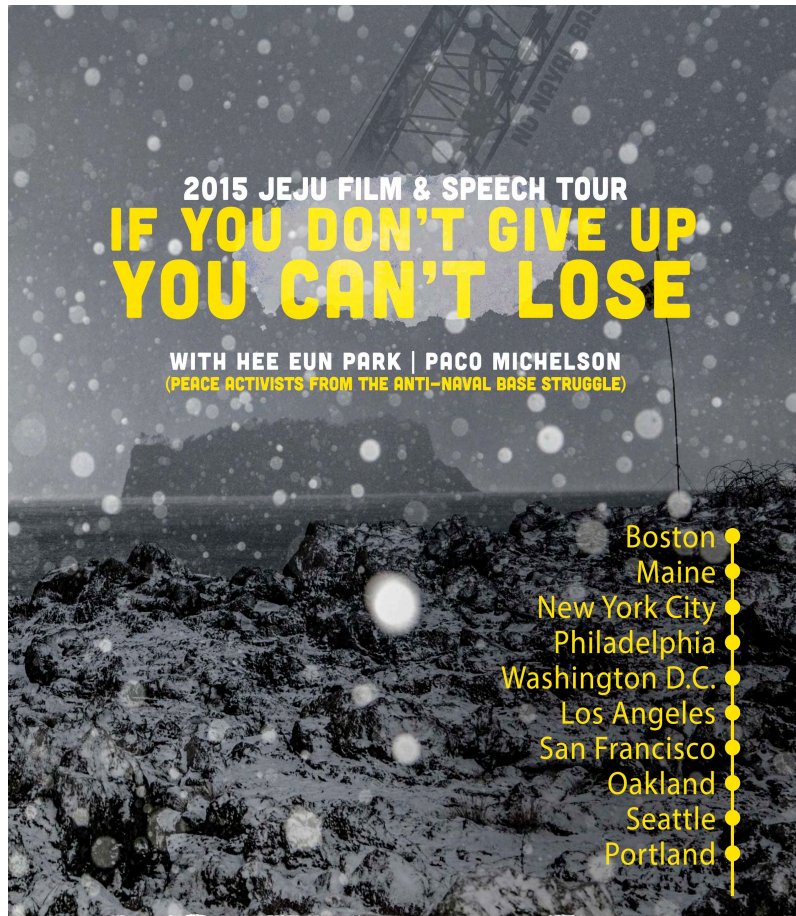


Solidarity with People of Jeju Island: The Long Struggle for Peace

A fascinating presentation by activists Hee Eun (Silver) Park and Paco Michelson, including scenes from the documentary of the struggle, *Gureombi, The Wind is Blowing* and Q&A.

The people of Gangjeong village on Jeju Island, S. Korea, have struggled for eight years to prevent the construction of a naval base that threatens their livelihoods, the local ecology, and the peace of northeast Asia. More than 220,000 police officers have been stationed in Gangjeong to contain the peaceful protest; 700 arrests have been made, leading to fines of close to \$270,000, imprisonment, and deportations. Come and hear about this passionate struggle from two courageous activists.

Hee Eun “Silver” Park and Paco Michelson are traveling across the US to share the story of the struggle. All funds raised will go to the legal costs of the activists and villagers of Gangjeong.
